
Summary

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How was the structure of the first-year students' number formed in the Hungarian higher education?

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After the appreciation the forecast of economy and workforce in Hungary, which is made under János Tímár's direction, the study analyses the forecast of demand and supply of graduates. It appoints that the forecast was exact to the growth and structure of economy. It points out that the number of graduates surpasses in the announced demand between 1995-2005. It mentions that the vertical structures of higher education deviates from the calculated need. Mainly the number and ration of holders of post-secondary qualification are behind.

One planning model is found in the study too. On the evidence of this model, the international data and the data of economic development the optimal structure of instruction could be calculated.
